Aims of the Programme

The aim of the programme is to introduce new and existing Directors of Research in Management and Business Schools to best practice in this professional position. Participants will get direct advice from experienced Directors, access to the gatekeepers of research funding institutions and the back up from a network of programme Alumni across the Continent. Module 2: The School View – Organization of Research Activities, including: Strategic choices - Large scale collaborative research, Evaluation of research outputs with respect to strategy, Organization for innovation, Defining and implementing a research strategy, Rankings, and Managing research under-performance

Module 3: The Practical View – Resources and Capabilities, including: Meet the editors, EU research activities, Research integrity, and Open innovation
